So, in order for us to serve you, please complete the census and join us at the Ministry Fair next Sunday. Why not also buy tickets for the Ravi-Oke event to be held at the Woodland next Sunday afternoon.

Finally, we look forward to see you at our Parish Pentecost celebration on May 28. On that Sunday, we will have only one Mass at 11:30 to symbolize our unity. Everyone should wear red for that celebration. Light refreshments will be provided after the Mass on Pentecost. We hope to see you there!
