ELIGIBILITY

All Parish children are welcome to register in our Program. Classes are held on scheduled Sunday mornings immediately following the 9:00am Family Mass. Registration opens in April. Sessions begin in late September, following a published calendar. Tuition is charged to cover part of our costs. Installment payments or financial assistance is available. Contact the pastor for further details.

EXPECTATIONS

To show proper respect for the materials, for our Catechists, and for fellow students, all children must be courteous and attentive. Should a problem arise, efforts will be made to solve it in class. If those efforts are unsuccessful, parents will be notified, along with the pastor.

CONCENTRATION

Our Volunteer Catechists have much to cover in a very short time. Focus and enthusiasm from the students make class time more enjoyable for everyone. Please let your child know how much their religious education means to you.

ATTENDANCE

Regular participation at Mass and in class are essential to a successful experience. Please plan to be at Church with your child each week either at the 9:00am Family Mass or the 11:30am Choir Mass. Please plan to make up any missed class work so your child can keep up momentum.
